This weekend we hear about the Vine and the Branches.

CATHOLIC CATECHESIS: DID YOU KNOW?

What is the *Kerygma*? It is a Greek word that means "proclamation." It is the Apostolic proclamation of salvation through Jesus Christ. The Kerygma is often described in terms of four essential elements:

God has a plan for your life

Sin interrupts that plan and separates you from God Jesus Christ died and rose so that you could be forgiven of these sins and be united to God in heaven Through faith and his Church, you can be united to God forever.
