This weekend we hear about the Vine and the Branches.

God the Father is vine grower. Jesus is the vine. We are the branches.

This is a great reminder that we are called to be intimately connected to God. Another great challenge is that it requires pruning.

It is understandable if we have a little trouble with the idea of being pruned. The more that we allow God to deal with our wounds, hurts, sins, and shortcomings, the healthier we will be. We should welcome any pruning by which God rids us of things that we don't need and changes our hearts and minds.

CATHOLIC CATECHESIS: DID YOU KNOW?

What is the *Kerygma*? It is a Greek word that means "proclamation." It is the Apostolic proclamation of salvation through Jesus Christ. The Kerygma is often described in terms of four essential elements:

God has a plan for your life

Sin interrupts that plan and separates you from God

Jesus Christ died and rose so that you could be forgiven of these sins and be united to God in heaven

Through faith and his Church, you can be united to God forever.

If you do not have a vital relationship with Christ, start with Mark's Gospel. Read it as straight through as you possibly can. Ask yourself as you are going through it: "What do the words and deeds of Jesus reveal to me about God the Father's heart?"
