#### MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

As we continue to celebrate Jesus' Resurrection, we celebrate mercy! Alleluia! Alleluia!

Today is named Divine Mercy Sunday.

This is a reminder of the incredible love of our God. We are called to ask for mercy and to believe that God desires to offer this profound gift to us! Once again, we can sometimes be blocked either by the mistaken belief that God would withhold mercy from us or that we cannot forgive ourselves. Mercy does involve healing and transformation and therefore we lift up our hearts to God!

And, in order to do this well, we must continue to surrender and to place our trust in Jesus.

We must have faith. We only have to look at the example of St. Thomas to see that this can sometimes be a challenge. Therefore, we pray that the truth of the resurrection may continue to sink deep into our hearts so that we will grow in faith and experience true mercy.

## **CATHOLIC CATECHESIS: DID YOU KNOW?**

On April 30, 2000, the first Sunday following Easter, Pope John Paul II both canonized Sister Faustina Kowalska and declared in his homily of that day his own desire that the "Second Sunday of Easter ... from now on throughout the world will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday."

It is important to understand that this is not a new feast day in the Church. Divine Mercy Sunday gives an additional name — a new "appellation" — to the day that is already a solemnity of the liturgical year — that is, the Second Sunday of Easter.
