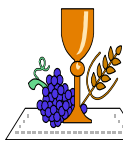
I look forward to staying in touch with all of you. I will let you know my mailing address when I get it. I will have some spare time and you may see my letter in the bulletin from time to time.

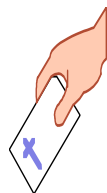
